

Snaggle Tooth Dinosaur Pattern

Some Ideas for how to use this pattern:

- Applique! Cut out the dinosaur from a bright colored fabric. Appliqué it to a t-shirt or onesie. Hand stitch the dino's eye, tooth, freckles and words with some embroidery thread.

How to do an appliqué?

- Use a fusible fabric glue (aka Heat N Bond or Stitch Witchery). Follow the directions on the package. Machine or hand stitch around your dinosaur to hold it in place.

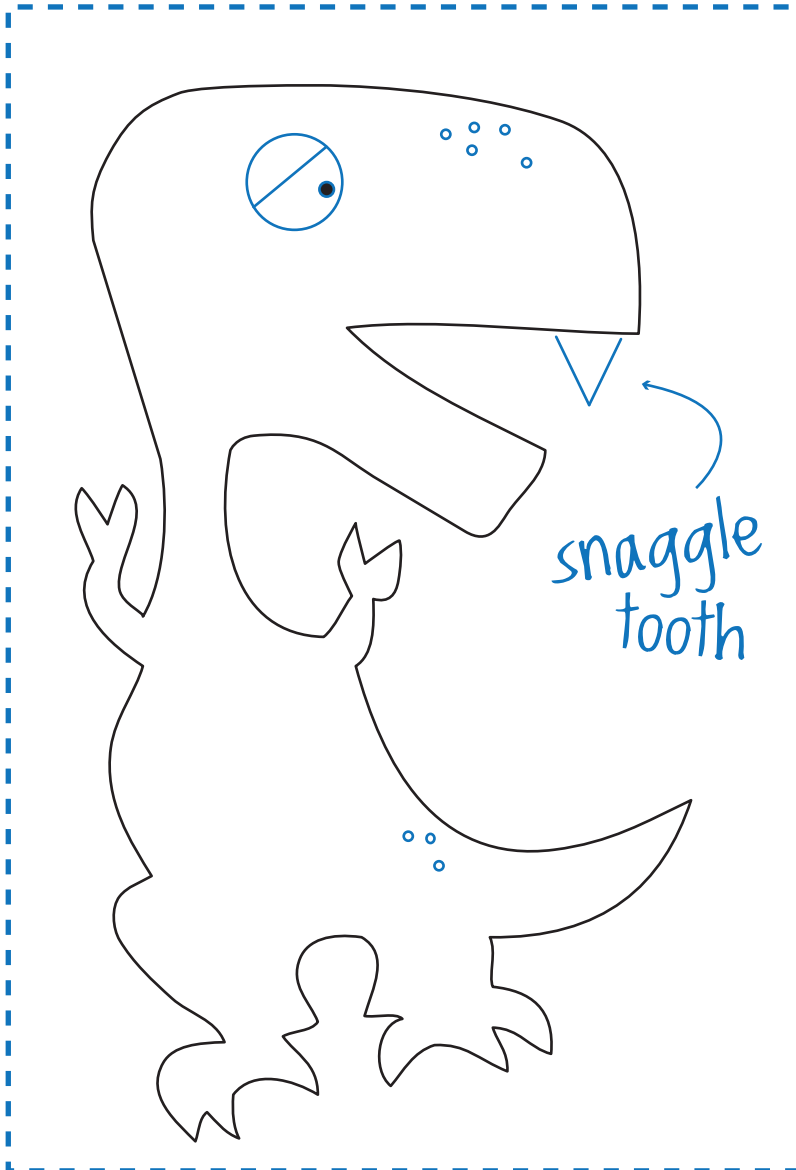
- Cut out a dino and use glue stick on the back of the fabric to stick it to the t-shirt and temporarily hold it in place. Stitch around it by machine or by hand.

- Go old school. Cut out the dino leaving a 1/4" seam allowance around the outside edge. Turn under the seam allowance and stitch down by hand.

- Embroider! Use a disappearing ink marker to trace this pattern on to your t-shirt or onesie and stitch over the lines. You can also trace the design on to water soluble or tear away stabilizer and stitch right through the t-shirt plus stabilizer. Remove the stabilizer when you are done.

- Stencil! Cut out the dino and use it as a stencil with fabric paint. Finish by painting the dino's eye and other details.
